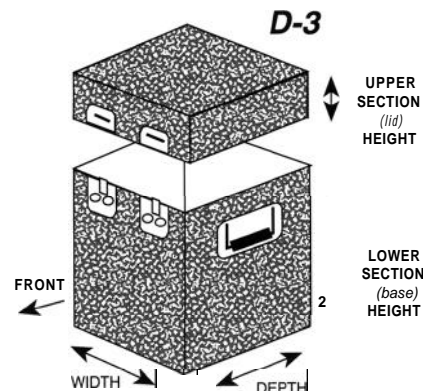


★ STYLE "D-3" - Removable 3" Lid

Style D-3 cases have a completely removable upper section (lid) which have catches on both sides. Style D-3 cases are typically used to avoid the contact, which tends to happen, with an attached hinge lid, during loading and unloading of case contents.

NOTE: Style D cases may have upper sections (lids) of varying heights. The upper section is minimally 3 inches in height, which is the space necessary, to accommodate heavy-duty hardware fittings. The lower section can be any height specified, provided it exceeds the 4 inch minimum height requirement. Letter "D" always precedes the upper section height (lid), i.e. D-3, D-4, D-5, etc.

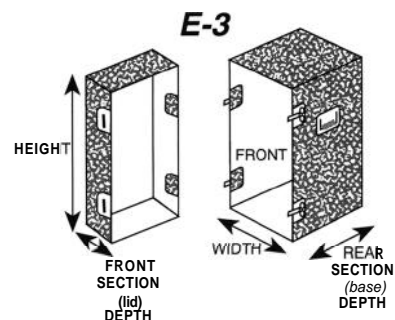


★ STYLE "E-3" - Removable 3" Front Lid

Style E-3 cases are sometimes referred to as roll-in styles due to the fact they have a removable 3 inch deep front section (lid) allowing easy access to the front for items that need to be rolled into a case. This style can be equipped with optional heavy-duty loading ramps for this purpose.

The front section of Style E-3 cases is completely removable and has catches on both sides. E-3 style cases may be equipped with multiple partitions, drawers, or glide-mounted shelves for organization of multiple items, to mention but a few available options.

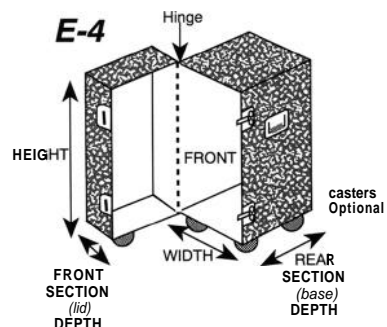
Style E-3 cases are ideally suited for items that might roll into the case, such as, roll-around carts, graphic printers/plotters, and larger industrial grade copy machines. The removable front section can be designed to accommodate collapsible leg assemblies which converts the lid into a useable and functioning table. ★ STYLE "E-4" - Hinged 4" Front Lid

Style E-4 cases have a front section (lid) which is 4 inches in depth and has a full-length piano-type hinge attaching it to the rear section (base) of case. Because the front section (lid) is 4 inches in depth, enough space is available to install an optional 5th caster to the lid which acts as a stabilizer to prevent the case from falling forward when case is open.

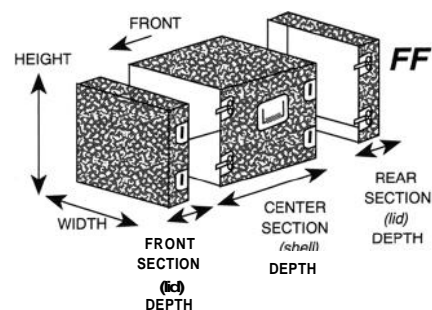
Common applications for Style E-4 cases are wardrobe cases, steamer trunks, multiple-drawer cases, or multiple-compartment organization cases. Style E-4 can also be used as a roll-in style case.



★ STYLE "FF" - Removable Front & Rear Lids

Style FF cases offer both a removable front and rear section (lid). This style is excellent when electronic components need both front and rear access to operate from within the case.

Items such as broadcast video tape decks, front loading audio tape machines, and computer disk and tape drives are well suited to Style FF cases. Interlocking tongue-and-groove valance is designed in such a way that both front and rear lid sections mate. This avoids damage, to valance edges, common to lids that don't have this interlocking STAR CASE feature. Precision manufacturing processes and tight production tolerances, enable us to offer this STAR CASE exclusive.



★ STYLE "X" - Telescopic Lid

Style X cases have an economical telescopic lid which resembles a large shoe box in design. The upper section (lid) overlaps the lower section (base) and can be designed to give a high degree of size variability. Economical webbed straps and steel buckles are used to secure case sections together.

Style X (for expo) are used primarily in the exhibit and trade show industry for transporting multiple exhibit panels, support rods, or graphic panels.
